What is a LIRP?

Fairtrade has developed a holistic price discovery model for establishing LIRPs, which constitutes an integral part of its Living Income strategy. A LIRP indicates the price needed for a full-time farmer with a sustainable productivity level to earn a living income. The model is derived from the universal human right for everyone who works to receive a just and favourable remuneration, ensuring an existence worthy of human dignity.

LIRP update

The LIRP for organic coconut from Côte d'Ivoire was originally estimated in 2024^[1]. To account for changes in both the cost of a decent standard of living for farmer households and on-farm production costs^[2], the original cost components have been adjusted using consumer price indices (CPI) for the period between February 2024 and July 2025. During this time, smallholder farmers in Côte d'Ivoire experienced an inflation rate of 2.16 %^[3]. This is the inflation used for this update.

The table below summarises the values from the original Living income reference price calculation, including the cost of decent living, cost of sustainable production, sustainable yields and viable crop area.

Based on these calculations, the updated Farmgate LIRP for 2025 is: **83** XOF/NUT
The resulting EXW LIRP is: **0.13** EUR/NUT - **0.15** USD/NUT^[4]

[2] This annual update does not include a reassessment of sustainable yields or viable land area. Instead, the LIRP adjustment is based solely on updated costs for sustainable production and decent living.
